Study environmental science (in English), take a Spanish language course at your skill level (beginners welcome), live with a welcoming homestay family, and earn up to six credits. After your studies, deepen your understanding of biodiversity, ecosystem function, and wildlife conservation during an immersive one-month internship at an Amazon wildlife rescue center and field station. Whether your focus is environmental science, veterinary science or a related discipline, we have a placement for you! You'll spend your days working with an amazing diversity of species—from capybaras to parrots—and learning from local experts.

Study Abroad - Take an environmental studies class in English and a Spanish language course at your language level, earning up to six credits at the Universidad de Cuenca.

- Elective options include *Natural Heritage of Ecuador*, *World Agriculture and Food Problems* and *Structure and Functions of Plants, Forestry and Society*.

Intern or Service-Learning - After your studies, venture into the Amazon and settle into a month-long placement at a wildlife rescue center focused on rehabilitation and release and an ecological field station focused on habitats.
