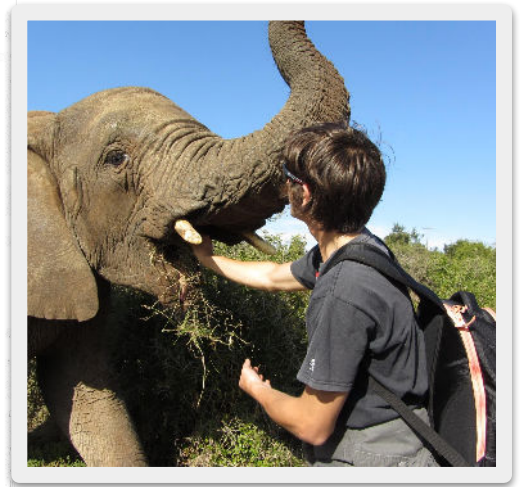
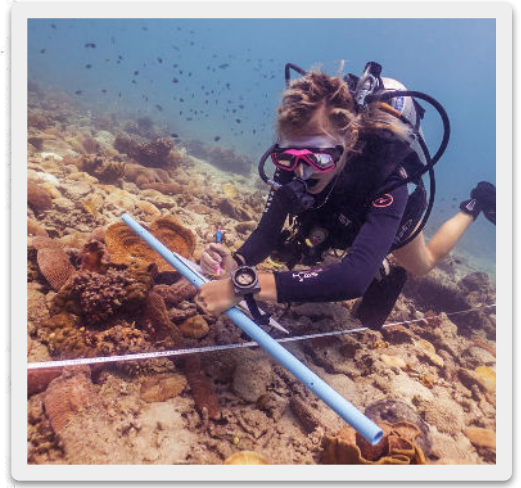

Veterinarian Work in South Africa

Work alongside a vet who helps elephants, reptiles, big cats and other species return to the wild by taking care of the rescued animals in a sanctuary on a reserve.

Gain a better understanding of issues facing a range of animals from big to small, domestic to wild. Work alongside local experts and learn how veterinary practice is approached in South Africa.

Get experience working in ecosystems and natural habitats with local scientists. Participate in wildlife monitoring and setting up camera traps.

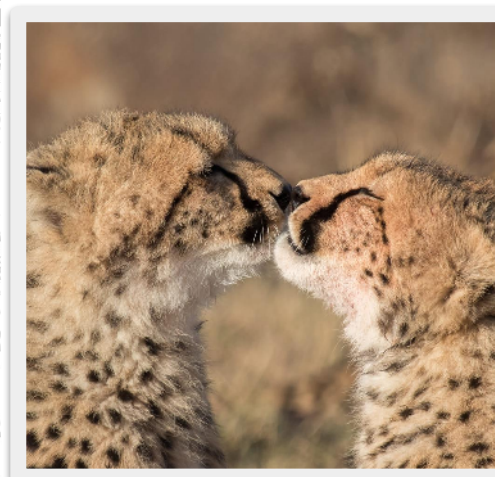

Whale and Dolphin Conservation Internship in Ecuador

Utilise cameras for whale identification and info collection, and help monitor populations of whales and dolphins to determine the impacts of environmental change.

Carry out marine research and monitoring activities under the guidance of project scientists. You'll collect data, through boat surveys, swims and scuba dives off the coast.

Dolphin and Marine Conservation in Zanzibar

Conservation and Ecology Internship in the Eswanti Savannah

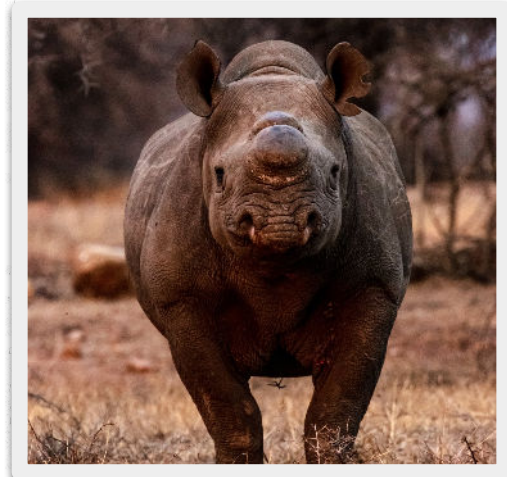
Focus on monitoring, researching and analysing data on a range of species such as raptors, bats, reptiles, and ungulates as well as recording variables about the habitats and vegetation.
