Eswatini

The 2nd smallest country of mainland Africa crams a lot of culture, wildlife and adventure into the only remaining African monarchy.

The kingdom of Eswatini is often seen as a microcosm of real Africa. Its strong tradition, vibrant cultural festivals and friendly, laid-back occupants welcome visitors into a very colourful world.

Considering its small size, it captures a lot of the best of African environment and wildlife, with the mountains running along its Mozambique border, its savannas in the East and its rainforests in the Northwest.

Eswatini has been badly hit by the HIV epidemic, to such an extent that it now has one of the world's highest rates of infection at around 25%. Alongside the levels of poverty, this has greatly impacted all areas of Swazi life and these projects seek to improve the futures of this beautiful little country.

Life outside of the project

Our projects are situated around 2 km outside Lobamba, in the heart of the Ezulwini Valley, where monuments, museums, culture and crafts can be found, and not far from the country's famous casino, the royal golf course and the hot mineral springs.

Volunteers live together in a lodge, relax in the TV room or chat outside in the tranquil gardens in the evenings after a hard day of work. The lodge also offers a pool table and a dart board for those with a bit more energy.

With plenty of adventure, from hikes to quad safaris, white water rafting and caving, there is plenty to do and plenty to see without going very far at weekends.

Small Business Development Internship and Product Design in Eswatini

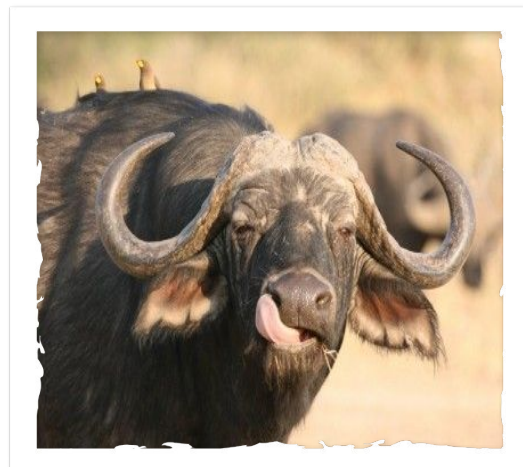
