Sharing the largest lake in Africa (Lake Victoria), Uganda is home to the source of the River Nile, where it starts its famous journey to the Mediterranean Sea. Uganda's western border is defined by the Albertan Rift, the western branch of the Great Rift Valley system of Africa with African Great Lakes plus the snow capped Ruwenzori Mountains (considered by many to be the legendary mountains of the moon).

One of the most popular things to do in Uganda is safaris, including trekking the elusive Mountain Gorillas among many other exciting fun adventures. Outside of Jinja, there are plenty of fun and interesting ways for visitors to spend their free time. You can take a trip to the most powerful waterfall in the world and see elephants, lions, giraffe, hippos, and a wide variety of birds like the unusual shoebill stork. You can tour Queen Elizabeth National Park, home to the diverse ecosystem of grassy plains, a tropical forest, swampland, and volcanic craters. You will be privileged to see schools of hippos and Nile-crocodiles sunbathing with their jaws open wide. In the capital of Kampala, you can take a tour of East Africa's oldest institution of higher learning (Makerere University) or visit the Uganda Museum, which offers displays on Uganda's history, anthropology and geography.
